

Directions & Suggestions

Supplies

- * Ruler or Straight Edge
- * Scissors or Xacto Knife (careful!)
- * Scoring Tool bone folder or the back of a butter knife
- * Paper For the cards, you will need nice cover stock suitable for your printer. I have used premium matte double-sided inkjet paper from OfficeMax on my Epson printer & it looks great! For the envelopes, a bright white text stock works well. You can even try printing the envelopes on your regular office paper.
- * Adhesive for Envelopes glue stick, double sided tape, etc.

What to Do

- * Open file in Adobe Acrobat. See, you did that already!
- * Select Print
- * Make sure "Scale to fit Paper" is NOT selected
- * Enter the page numbers you would like to print in "Copies & Pages"
- * Print weeeeee!
- * Cut along the the solid blue lines.
- * For the envelopes, after cutting them out, place ruler along the blue dashed lines & score with your scoring tool. __ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _
- * Fold along scoring. Run your scoring tool down the fold to make a nice sharp crease.
- * Apply adhesive along the pink dots. Then fold the flaps with the adhesive facing in, & press the bottom flap of the envelope up, sticking it to the adhesive.
- * Optional If you would like to purchase envelopes instead of making them, the mini cards will fit snugly into Florist or Business Card size envelopes.
